The National Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries will launch three major projects in the Northern Cape this week under the theme, "Together, We can do more through Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries"

The projects to be launched are:

1. The R 1 billion Flood Relief Scheme which is aimed at reconstruction of the damaged Agricultural Infrastructure during the recent floods in and around the lower orange and other parts of the province.
2. The Fire Relief scheme which is aimed at providing relief and comprehensive assistance to the Agricultural community as a result of the recent veld fires that ravaged the province in the recent past.
3. The Agricultural Mechanization project which is aimed at providing mechanized agricultural implements and equipment's to deserving beneficiaries in all the five districts of the province.

Among those who are expected to be part of the event are the Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, other Cabinet Ministers from the Executive, MEC Norman Shushu and other MECs of Agriculture, Leadership of the provincial and local governments, organized agriculture, and the farmers.
